Background: As a cooperative effort between ITEP, IEN, and BMT, scholarships are available for tribal participants or those representing tribal agencies.

Who should apply: Anyone affiliated with a tribe or a tribal organization and that has a strong interest in water issues should apply for the scholarship. Scholarships are limited. Decisions on who gets the scholarships will be made by a committee representing ITEP, IEN, and BMT, based on the information provided in this application. Applicants should include grassroots activists, as well as tribal staff and interested community members.

Scholarship: The scholarship will include conference registration, 2 nights lodging in a local hotel (max \$120.00), a \$100 mileage and per diem stipend and participation in the Tribal Dinner on August 3, 2005. Reimbursement documentation will need to be completed during the conference to obtain the funding. A receipt for lodging must be turned in with the application for reimbursement. Reimbursement (lodging and stipend) will be received in the mail approximately 3 weeks following the conference.

Travel and Hotel Arrangements: You will need to make your own travel and hotel arrangements. The scholarship is intended for those that plan to fully participate in the conference. If you don't intend to attend all the conference sessions, please do not apply for a scholarship.

Additional Responsibilities: If there is any reason that you will not be able to attend after receiving the scholarship, please notify Enei Begaye, IEN, at ienwater@igc.org or 928 213 9760 so that another person can be selected for the scholarship. You may NOT transfer the scholarship to another person.

Registration: Complete the Arizona Water Summit Registration Form and FAX it with the Scholarship application to Enei Begaye. If you are not awarded a scholarship, you may still attend the conference, but you will need to pay the registration fees.
